The PAC College of Architecture Prize

Award

- This award celebrates the excellence that emerges from a collaborative process.
- The winning team receives an award and \$2,500.

Eligibility

- Eligible collaborative projects will consist of two or more students with at least one student from the College of Architecture programs (undergraduate, graduate or professional programs).
- The project must emerge from curricular or college work, excluding professional work and work from an internship.
- The work must have been completed during the year beginning and ending in May (summer, fall, spring).

Submission Criteria

- The file should be in PDF format (limited to 20mb) accompanied by a 500 word description of the project highlighting how collaboration contributed to a quality project.
- Award selection is based on the best quality of work.

Selection Process

- The faculty selection committee consists of one faculty member from each discipline in the college. If necessary, the dean will act as tie-breaker.
- For the first stage, the faculty committee selects three to five finalists from the submissions.
- During second stage, the finalists present projects to PAC executive committee members.
- The schedule is based on an academic year.
 - Students must submit by Monday (noon) of the spring semester final review/university dead week.
 - A shortlist is developed by Friday of final review week, and the finalists are notified.
 - Shortlisted projects are presented to the PAC Executive Committee during finals week.
 - PAC Executive Committee selects the winning team during finals week.
 - The prize is awarded during the CoA graduation ceremony.
