ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES

Developed the proposal for acquisition, establishment, and display of the Eloise Kruger Miniature Collection. This resulted in an \$1,000,000.00 donation to the Interior Design Program in addition to a collection of scaled miniature furniture and the endowment for its conservation and support. This has resulted in a \$50,000 per year increase in funding to the Interior Design Program. Resources from the endowment have been used for the establishment of a new journal for Interior Design entitled *In.Form*. In addition, the endowment has supported undergraduate scholarships and graduate research assistantships.

In conjunction with the University Foundation, developed a proposal for the development of scholarship funds for the Interior Design Program.

Coordinated the establishment of the College of Architecture on the University of Nebraska-Omaha Campus. Two year programs in pre-architecture and pre-interior design were established. Upon successful completion of the two year program, students make application to the professional programs in architecture and interior design on the University of Nebraska Lincoln Campus.

Coordinated the development of a graduate program in Interior Design and prepared written proposal for approval. Documentation was prepared for presentation to the Department and College faculty, the University Graduate Council, and the Post Secondary Commission. The program was approved in the Spring of 2001. The graduate program is now available as a resident student and through distance education.

Coordinated the review and revision of course competencies and objectives for all Interior Design courses in the department to be sure they met CIDA Accreditation guidelines and provided a sound educational process for those students majoring in Interior Design.

Recruitment and Retention

Planned and conducted week long Career Exploration Workshops for high school students interested in interior design and architecture. Many went on to enroll in the College of Architecture at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

Developed and organized a program of Student Ambassadors and Peer Mentors for the College. The Student Ambassadors work with prospective students and their parents and participate in special events of the Programs and College.

Established organization of and prepared written material for the Undergraduate Student Guide with Dr. Sharon Kuska and David Cronrath.
