He is a past president of the Omaha chapter of the American Institute of Architects' Board of Directors, and a graduate of Leadership Omaha (Class 31). Mike co-created the Kaneko Architecture Design Camps, which allow adolescents to explore urban Omaha through design. Now in its eighth year.
